Class Supplies:

- Reading: 1 subject notebook, folder for loose papers, highlighters, headphones/earbuds, PENCILS, PENCILS, and MORE PENCILS
- Social Studies: folder

Homework: Students are expected to do their assigned homework. We always start work in class and material will be based on what students have been taught. The purpose of homework is for students to review previously learned skills or information. Practicing these skills will promote comprehension and individual growth.

- Points will be deducted for late assignments and will be noted as late in PowerSchool.
- Assignments that are not turned in at all will result in a 0% and be noted as missing in PowerSchool.

- **Remind APP:** I send home a code for parents and students to sign up for the Remind App for my class. Using this app, I will send you a daily email or text (your preference) of daily assignments or announcements.

- Students that are absent, as per the student handbook, will have 3 days per missed day to make up any missed work. Please refer to the handbook for consequences of copying or plagiarism.



Teacher Expectations:

Students are expected to follow the school rules described in the MS handbook. My classroom rules are as follows.

1. **RESPECT** people and their property
2. **Be PREPARED** for class. Bring a pencil, notebook and homework.
3. **Be RESPONSIBLE** for your work and your own actions.
4. **ASK** if you have any questions.

Discipline/Consequences: Our school participates in the PBIS behavior management program where we support positive behavior. In the event that students do not comply with district or classroom rules, the following will occur.

1. Verbal warning or conference with the student privately.
2. Contact parent. If undesired behavior continues in my classroom, I will contact the parent directly.
3. Discipline referral filed with the principal if behavior continues or progresses.
