1. submersible	n. a small vehicle designed for underwater research and exploration. EX: The crew in the submersible saw a giant squid up close.
2. intrepid	adj. fearless, adventurous EX: The intrepid marines rescued the prisoners.
3. propulsion	n. act of driving or pushing forward EX: The propulsion of the boat slowed down.
4. robotic	adj. of or relating to a device that can perform difficult tasks, either automatically or on command EX: The mechanic had to fix the robotic arm.
5. emerge	v. to move away from something and come into view, appear EX: The fireman will emerge from the burning building.
6. attracted	v. made to come closer because of a special feature EX: The mouse was attracted to the cheese
7. simultaneously	adj. at the same time EX: We both said "Happy birthday!" simultaneously.
8. dominant	adj. most important, powerful, or influential The alpha wolf is the the most dominant.
9. expectantly	adv. having or showing excitement about something that is about to happen, especially if the event is pleasant or interesting. EX: She expectantly waited for her friend to arrive.
10. disapprovingly	adv. done in a manner showing disagreement EX: The teacher looked at the student disapprovingly when he put his feet on the desk.
11. exasperated	adj. annoyed or angry EX: Sharon was exasperated when she found her homework in her dog's mouth.
12. resume	v. to go on or continue after an interruption EX: After the commercial, my show resumed.

Character	who or what the story is about
Conflict	a struggle or problem in the story
Theme	message the playwright wants the audience to understand
Actors	people who act out the play
Script	written text that include the lines the characters say
	Types of Themes
Friendship	The characters develop a bond or friendship.
Teamwork	The characters work together to accomplish something.
Nature vs. Man	The characters survive a natural disaster or situation created by nature.
Good vs. Evil	Good characters are victorious over evil.
