Use the following definitions to complete the graphic organizer on types of characters.

Types of Characters:

1. Round: a character in a story whose different sides of personality are all shown in the story
2. Flat: a character in a story where only one side of their personality is shown in the story
3. Dynamic: a character in a story that changes over time
4. Static: a character in a story that does not change much over time
5. Protagonist: the main character or central person in a story, "good guy"
6. Antagonist: a character in a story who opposes the protagonist, usually recognized as the "bad guy"
